As of August 27th at 9:00pm:

Our original event has been broken into four (4) separate races, with clearly defined start and finish times that will see no more than 60 riders together at any time.

Race #1 is on Saturday, August 28th from 8:00am-1:00pm

Race #2 is on Saturday, August 28th from 12:00pm-5:00pm

Race #3 is on Sunday, August 29th from 7:00am-12:00pm

Race #4 is on Sunday August 29th from 11:00am-4:00pm

Registration and Staging Location:

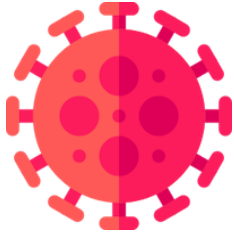
- **Do not drive to registration, walk or bike only.**

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



All participants must follow the [Interior Health Regions new health measures that were introduced on August 23rd, 2021](#). Further information can be found on the [Provincial COVID-19 webpage](#). Below is a shortlist of common practices that athletes must adhere to:

- Failure to comply with *Provincial* guidelines and [Panorama Mountain Resort guidelines](#) will result in immediate disqualification from the event and all future events.
- Participants should complete a [Self Assessment](#) prior to attending the event. If you're feeling unwell or showing any symptoms please stay home.
- Participants must remain at least 2 meters apart. Face coverings must be worn at all times where/when social distancing cannot be maintained.

GENERAL INFORMATION



Read below for event specific important information

- This event is for **EXPERT** riders only, not suitable for beginners.
- All minors (18+ under) attending must have a parent or legal guardian present in order to sign Panorama Event Waiver. See Registration info below.
- Due to COVID there is no Racer Briefing. Please ride smart!
- **Full Face Helmets are MANDATORY, for ALL Racers**
 - Helmets must be worn at all times while on course
- No E-bikes allowed on lifts. This is not an E-bike race.
- Departure time listed in the schedule is when you are permitted to begin the course route on race day.
- **Injured Rider on Course**
If you come across an injured rider you must stop and dial patrol at 1.250.341.3650
 - Patrol will be identified by Red/Black Jerseys with white crosses.
- **Aid Stations - there are no water or aid stations**
 - Athletes must carry a face covering at all times.
- No riders to ride UPHILL in the bike park on training days, with the exception of accessing the trails above the Mile 1 Chair Lift or trails outside of the bike park.



COURSE INFORMATION

The bike park is open to the public throughout our event. Please be courteous and maintain social distance.

- The course for all four races is identical.

- Spectators are not permitted.



TRAINING // COURSE INSPECTION

Training/Practice

- **All riders need a lift ticket to access the mountain for practice.**
- There is no Practice or Training on the course as of 10:00pm on Friday, August 27th.
- No hiking up the bike trails. The bike park is NOT closed to the public. DO NOT stop or hike on the trail. If you want to take a closer look at a line, pull to the side of the trail and hike off-of the trail.

REGISTRATION PROCESS AT THE EVENTS

1. All racers must have a valid lift pass. All athletes must purchase a lift ticket for from [Guest Services](#).
 - 1.1. If you have a season pass to Panorama Bike Park, you do not need to go to guest services.
 - 1.2. Lift tickets - when purchasing your lift ticket please specify you are competing in the Norco Canadian Enduro Series and have your proof of purchase ready. You will be given a discount.
2. Saturday before you race:
 - 2.1. Please review your registration time in the SCHEDULE section below for your Race Categories specific registration time.
3. Saturday, DAY 1:
Head to the Registration/Staging Location.
 - Registration is closed.
 - All registration must occur online.
 - **There are NO on-site registrations accepted.**
 - There are NO package pickups before your scheduled time.
 - All minors (18 + under) must have a parent present to sign the Panorama resort waiver. If a parent cannot be present, please provide a signed letter noting who the legal guardian is with proof of ID. Friends are not allowed to sign for minors.



RESULTS & TIMING

IMPORTANT

- **TIMING CHIPS**

Every racer will be given a timing chip on Saturday at registration.

- Due to COVID racers must only return their timing chip during the specified times below.
- Please do not return your timing chip at any other time, unless injured or withdrawing from the race. If you need to return your timing chip early please call 1-778-257-6084.
- Please ensure your timing chip is put on your right hand wrist and is worn at all times while on course. Timing chips are the responsibility of the racer. Lost timing chips incur a \$100.00 charge.

RETURNING YOUR TIMING CHIP

Below are the times that racers may return their timing chip.

No spectators or family members are allowed, racers only.

Timing chips not returned during the scheduled times will be charge \$100.00

AWARDS

- Due to COVID, there is no general awards ceremony
- If you have placed in 1st, 2nd or 3rd for your registration category cohort., we invite you to the Registration/Staging Area at the following times for a quick, socially distanced photo. Masks are mandatory.

- Race #2 = 6:30-7:00pm - Saturday, August, 28th
- Race #3 = 2:30-3:00pm -Saturday, August, 28th
- Race #4 = 6:30-7:00pm - Saturday, August, 28th
- Masks are mandatory and must be on before you arrive.
- No spectators, family are allowed to attend, racers only.
- Due to COVID we are limiting spectators during our awards ceremony.

SCHEDULE

IMPORTANT

- ★ **REGISTRATION AND PLATE PICKUP** - This is the time window in which you must pickup your timing chip, number plate and sign waivers. Registration is Saturday only.
- ★ **DEPARTURE TIME**
 - All racers depart immediately after registration.
 - Come to registration prepared to leave immediately after receiving your timing chip
- ★ **RACER BRIEFING** - Due to COVID there is not a racer briefing. We sent an email on Thursday with other information.

- ★ There is no priority access for racers in the lift line - be kind, do not cut in front of other people, you are representing the entire sport of enduro racing.
- ★ Timing Tags not handed in during the times mentioned in the RESULTS section will incur a charge of \$100.00 and be considered 'lost'.

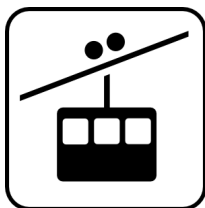


ALL OTHER EVENT INFO



PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Masks > all participants must keep a mask on their person at all times. Face coverings must be worn at all times where/when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Hand Sanitizer > all participants must keep hand sanitizer on their person at all times.
- Full Face helmet is MANDATORY for ALL riders.
- Knee pads are strongly recommended. So are gloves, elbow pads, eye protection and back braces.

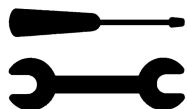
LIFT TICKET PRICING

- **Show proof of registration to get a discounted lift ticket - no race registration = no discounted lift ticket** > online reg closes on TUESDAY at 12:00pm.
- Race day tickets 15% off (Saturday and Sunday)
- All racers must purchase a lift ticket from Guest Services before picking up their race plate.
- It is very important that we respect the rules of the resort, please be kind and courteous to all staff and respectful of the lift line rules.





AID STATION

There are no aid stations or water stations.
 Food/Water caches/stashes are forbidden. Athletes found stashing food/water will be disqualified.

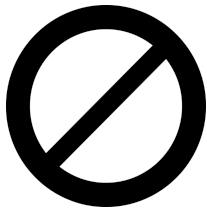

REFUND POLICY

They must submit a doctor's note stating that they are unable to ride a bike for the duration of the race season. Doctor's notes must be submitted a minimum 10 days before the given event.
